

LOGISTICS & LOCAL CUSTOMIZATION

- ▶ **30-minute** pre-recorded virtual theatre piece.
- ▶ Presenter receives access to a **link for a finite amount of time** (i.e.: 7 days).
- ▶ Broadcast **resolution up to 4K** (suitable viewing on laptop, tablet, or TV).
- ▶ **Closed captioning available** for ADA compliance.
- ▶ Recording can be **personalized for venue/school district** with a welcome from Sugar Skull (i.e.: *Welcome to Brooklyn Center for the Performing Arts!*). Presenter provides a picture of inside or outside of venue to be projected on the green screen behind the actor.
- ▶ Presenter can opt-in to **add-on education modules** for an additional fee.
- ▶ Presenter can opt-in to **live Q&A sessions** with any member of the cast/creative/technical team for an additional fee, pending availability.
- ▶ Additional services can be crafted to personalize the experience even more for your venue or institution — **happy to brainstorm and create together!**
